February 20, 2014 – Introduced by Representatives SHANKLAND, JORGENSEN, BARCA, HESSELBEIN, JOHNSON, DOYLE, KAHL, WACHS, SINICKI, CLARK, C. TAYLOR, MILROY, BEWLEY, VRUWINK, PASCH, SARGENT, WRIGHT, BILLINGS, SMITH, ZEPNICK, ZAMARRIPA and HULSEY.

- 1 **Relating to:** requiring the Committee on Assembly Organization to immediately
2 appoint a joint task force on clean and renewable energy.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The resolution requires the Committee on Assembly Organization to immediately appoint a joint task force on clean and renewable energy, consisting of an equal number of majority and minority party members, to devise ways to facilitate the development of clean energy solutions, create jobs while reducing pollution, move Wisconsin away from fossil fuel-based energy production, and prevent foreign nations from dominating the clean energy field.

Under the resolution, the task force must deliver its findings to the assembly before February 1, 2015.

5 consisting of an equal number of members of the majority and minority parties, to
6 devise ways to facilitate the development of clean energy solutions, create jobs while

1 and prevent foreign nations from dominating the clean energy field. The task force
2 shall deliver its findings to the assembly before February 1, 2015.
