Wisconsin Administrative Code section Ins 6.11 (3)(a)2) states, "Failure to initiate and conclude a claims investigation with all reasonable dispatch."

Page 2, Line 7- (b) No insurer may fail to initiate or conclude with due dispatch an investigation of a claim for repairs to a motor vehicle on the basis of whether the repairs will be made by a particular contractor or repair facility.

We would like it changed to reflect the administrative rule. Simply, change the "OR" into an "AND".
