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## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 470

December 21, 2015 – Offered by Representative MURSAU.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	<b>1.</b> Page 6, line 9: after that line insert:
3	"SECTION 9c. 23.33 (2) (ir) 1. of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin Act
4	89, is renumbered 23.33 (2) (ir).
5	SECTION 9e. 23.33 (2) (ir) 2. of the statutes is repealed.".
6	${f 2.}$ Page 7, line 16: delete lines 16 to 18 and substitute:
7	"(n) "Law enforcement officer" has the meaning given in s. 23.33 (1) (ig).".
8	<b>3.</b> Page 24, line 16: delete "town" and substitute "city, village, or town".
9	<b>4.</b> Page 47, line 4: after that line insert:
10	"SECTION 16d. 23.47 (1) (am) of the statutes is created to read:
11	23.47 (1) (am) An off-highway motorcycle registration certificate, a validated
12	registration receipt, or a registration decal under s. 23.335.

SECTION 16f. 23.47 (2) of the statutes, as created by 2015 Wisconsin Act 89, is
 amended to read:

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3 23.47 (2) ELECTRONIC RETRIEVAL OF INFORMATION. If the department maintains 4 a system under which the department stores information in an electronic format that 5 relates to individuals who have been issued approvals under ch. 29 or safety 6 certificates under s. 23.33, 23.335, 30.74, or 350.055, the department may issue a 7 conservation card to any individual who applies for the card for purposes of enabling 8 the department to access information about that individual in the system. The 9 department may authorize an individual to carry a conservation card or another 10 form of identification, determined by the department, in lieu of carrying proof under 11 sub. (1).

SECTION 16h. 23.47 (3) (a) (intro.) of the statutes, as created by 2015 Wisconsin
Act 89, is amended to read:

14 23.47 (3) (a) (intro.) The department may maintain a system under which an
15 individual may obtain a reprint of certain approvals under ch. 29 and safety
16 certificates under s. ss. 23.33 and 23.335 and chs. 29, 30, and 350. The department
17 shall designate, by rule, all of the following:

24 (<u>4) (f) 2.</u>, 30.52 (1m) (a) 3., or 350.12 (3h) (a) 3. may retain 50 cents of each issuing
25 fee for each document reprinted to compensate for services in issuing the reprint.

sub. (1) if an all-terrain vehicle, utility terrain vehicle, <u>off-highway motorcycle</u>, boat,
 or snowmobile does not visibly display a registration plate or decal under s. 23.33 (2)
 <u>or 23.335 (4) (c) or (5) (c)</u>, a nonresident trail pass under s. 23.33 (2j) <u>or 23.335 (6)</u>,
 a registration or certification decal under s. 30.523 (2), or a registration decal or trail
 use sticker under s. 350.12 (5).".

1	<b>7.</b> Page 68, line 7: delete lines 7 to 10 and substitute:
2	"SECTION 76m. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the first day of the 7th
3	month beginning after publication except as follows:
4	(1) The treatment of section 23.33 (2) (ir) 1. and 2. of the statutes takes effect
5	on March 1, 2016.".
