Sen. Harsdorf requests the following amendment to SB 618.

Section 8: This bill amends the definition of child sex trafficking. The Crime Victim Council discussed amending the definition, to, by adding "solicits' and "patronizes" (and attempts), to mirror the federal definition and acknowledge that buyers promote/facilitate child sex trafficking:



State. 948.051 (Trafficking of a child) "(1) Whoever knowingly recruits, entices, provides, obtains, [transports], solicits, patronizes, or harbors, or knowingly attempts to recruit, entice, provide, obtain, [transport], solicit, patronize or harbor, any child for the purposes of commercial sex acts, as defined in s. 940.302 (1)(a) is guilty of a Class C felony."



# PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION SENATE AMENDMENT,

#### **TO SENATE BILL 618**



At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 5, line 22: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with page 6, line 2, and substitute:

"Section 6m. 948.051 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

948.051 (1) Whoever knowingly recruits, entices, provides, obtains, or harbors, transports, patronizes, or solicits or knowingly attempts to recruit, entice, provide, obtain, or harbor, transport, patronize, or solicit any child for the purpose of commercial sex acts, as defined in s. 940.302 (1) (a), is guilty of a Class C felony.".
