Elisabeth,

Sen. Harsdorf requests the following amendment to SB 618.

Section 8: This bill amends the definition of child sex trafficking. The Crime Victim Council discussed amending the definition, to, by adding "solicits" and "patronizes" (and attempts), to mirror the federal definition and acknowledge that buyers promote/facilitate child sex trafficking:

Wis. State. 948.051 (Trafficking of a child) "(1) Whoever knowingly recruits, entices, provides, obtains, [transports], solicits, patronizes, or harbors, or knowingly attempts to recruit, entice, provide, obtain, [transport], solicit, patronize or harbor, any child for the purposes of commercial sex acts, as defined in s. 940.302 (1)(a) is guilty of a Class C felony."

4 "SECTION 6m. 948.051 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 948.051 (1) Whoever knowingly recruits, entices, provides, obtains, or harbors,
6 transports, patronizes, or solicits or knowingly attempts to recruit, entice, provide,
7 obtain, or harbor, transport, patronize, or solicit any child for the purpose of
8 commercial sex acts, as defined in s. 940.302 (1) (a), is guilty of a Class C felony."
