### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill adds a penalty if if person knowingly causes intentional injury to judge, prosecutor, or law enforcement officer, in response to an action taken by one of these players. Current law already prohibits such action against a judge and his/her family. There should be no fiscal impact if these additional penalties are provided for intentional injury to law enforcement officers and prosecutors' families.
