Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a requirement that the Division of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (DMHSAS) set forth conditions of release for those persons who are released to the community after being held in civil commitment for certain serious sex offenses. This bill puts into statute conditions on supervised release that are currently being imposed by DMHSAS through policy. Therefore, the Department does not anticipate a fiscal effect as a result of this bill.
