Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill, if enacted, will establish requirements and prohibitions for complementary and alternative health care (CAHC) practitioners; provide exemptions for CAHC practitioners from prohibitions against acting without certain health-care related licenses, certificates, and other credentials; and, modify the authority of the Department of Safety and Professional Services.

Prosecutors do not anticipate a fiscal impact on their offices should this bill be enacted.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

No long-term fiscal impact on District Attorney offices is expected should this bill be enacted.
