Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill gives a victim of sexual assault, human trafficking, or child abuse the right to request accompaniment by a victim advocate to an examination or consultation, and provides certain rights to be accompanied by an advocate to certain interviews or proceedings related to the crime.

Prosecutors believe that if done well, the process should provide more support for victims, which should encourage more to cooperate with the criminal justice system. This would increase the number of cases. Because it is uncertain how many new cases may be initiated, a fiscal estimate is indeterminate.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

As stated above, the long-term fiscal impact of this bill, should it be enacted, is indeterminate.
