## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, a volunteer fire fighter, emergency medical technician, or first responder in a city, village, or town whose annual compensation, including fringe benefits, does not exceed \$15,000 may also hold elective office in that local government.

The proposed bill raises the annual compensation limit to \$25,000. However, data is not readily available to estimate, under the provisions of this bill, the number of individuals that will benefit from the proposed bill; therefore, the local fiscal impact is indeterminable.
