Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB-764 makes a one-time transfer of \$500,000 in FY16 from WEDC's general programs and operations appropriation to the Department of Administration. In addition, the bill directs the department to grant \$500,000 to Prosperity Southwest Wisconsin to fund a revolving loan program for the purpose of funding regional economic development and entrepreneurial start-ups.

The transfer of \$500,000 from WEDC to DOA in FY16 will have a net neutral fiscal effect on the State, however, this may require WEDC to divert funding from existing programs and activities to support the statutory requirements.
