### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2015 AB 792 requires a law enforcement agency that has issued an alert for a missing adult at risk, to refer the person making the report to a local aging and disability resource center. The law would also require DOT to review the driver's license of the person who is the subject of the alert to determine if restrictions should be imposed on the person's license. These requirements should result in no fiscal impact to DOJ.
