Description Insurance requirements for vehicle rental companies		

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill clarifies that the provisions relating to "rental companies" in section 194.41(1) Wis. Stats., apply only to rental company vehicles that are rented to a common motor carrier of property, contract motor carrier, or private motor carrier transporting hazardous materials as listed under Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations 172.101. This proposal will have no fiscal impact on WisDOT.
