Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, a person may not act as or advertise for the provision of services as an ambulance service provider unless that person holds the required Wisconsin license.

Under SB 182, ambulance service providers that make ten or fewer patient transports per year that originate and terminate in Wisconsin would be exempt from that requirement. The bill will not have a fiscal impact on the Department.
