### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SB 204 increases the penalties to a Class H felony that may be charged to a person who causes intentional bodily harm to a child welfare worker or juvenile justice worker employed by the Wisconsin Department of Children and Families (DCF) or employed by a licensed child welfare agency contracting with DCF or a county department of human services or social services whose position involves intake, dispositional, or other child welfare or juvenile justice services.

This change in law would not directly affect any appropriations related to DCF, county departments of human services or social services, or their respective contracted entities.
