Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current federal law allows an exemption for state legislators per diem expenses if the legislator's place of residence is more than 50 miles from the state capitol. Wisconsin conforms to this federal law, so these amounts are also exempt from Wisconsin income.

Current state law also allows an exemption for per diem expenses of legislators to the extent that those expenses have not already been excluded from federal adjusted gross income. Because the Wisconsin law does not limit the exclusion to legislators whose place of residence is more than 50 miles from the state capitol, it primarily extends the state exclusion to legislators whose place of residence is within 50 miles of the state capitol.

This bill repeals the state income tax exclusion for legislator's per diem expenses beginning in 2016. This effectively eliminates the per diem exclusion for legislators whose place of residence is within 50 miles of the state capitol, but does not affect the federal exclusion for legislators whose place of residence is more than 50 miles from the state capitol. The bill will increase revenue by a minimal amount annually, beginning in fiscal year 2017.
