<b>Description</b> Standards and ordinances regulating shoreland zoning					

### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill repeals shoreland zoning provisions made under the 2015-2017 biennial budget (2015 Act 55). The provisions changed the authority that counties have in the development of a shoreland ordinance that is more restrictive than the shoreland zoning standards in NR 115 and 59.592, and made changes to other shoreland zoning standards.

#### State Fiscal Effect

The bill would have no fiscal effect on the Department since the workload needed to comply with Act 55 shoreland zoning changes has already been performed.

#### Local Fiscal Effect

The bill is not anticipated to have a local fiscal impact either. Regardless of the Act 55 shoreland zoning changes, local units of government have already been in the process of revising ordinances to bring them into compliance with updates made to NR 115 (i.e., the Department's shoreland protection administrative code). The deadline for a complying ordinance is October 1, 2016.
