Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The tentative collective bargaining agreement between the Board of Regents and the Wisconsin State Building Trades Negotiating Committee calls for a zero-percent increase in base wages for the 2015-16 fiscal year. Please note that the agreement relates only to classified employees of the University of Wisconsin System, excluding employees working on the UW-Madison campus, who are members of the crafts workers collective bargaining unit.

A zero-percent base wage increase is not expected to have a fiscal impact.
