



## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

**2015 Wisconsin Act 93**  
[2015 Senate Bill 93]

**Motor Vehicle Repair Practices**

2015 Wisconsin Act 93 prohibits an insurer that issues a motor vehicle insurance policy that covers repairs to a motor vehicle from: (1) requiring that repairs must be made by a particular contractor or repair facility as a condition of that coverage; and (2) failing to initiate or conclude with due dispatch an investigation of a claim for repairs on the basis of whether the repair will be made by a particular contractor or repair facility.

*Effective date and initial applicability:* The Act took effect on November 13, 2015 and first applies to a claim made under a motor vehicle insurance policy on that date. If a motor vehicle insurance policy that is in effect on November 13, 2015 contains a provision that is inconsistent with 2015 Wisconsin Act 93, the Act first applies to a claim made under that policy on that date on which the policy is renewed.
