

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2015 Wisconsin Act 191 [2015 Assembly Bill 682]

Department of Revenue Remedial Legislation

2015 Wisconsin Act 191 is remedial legislation, introduced by the Joint Legislative Council's Law Revision Committee at the request of the Department of Revenue.

The Act does the following:

- Removes a reference to the Elections Board, which was eliminated by 2007 Wisconsin Act 1.
- Removes all statutory references to the defunct Woodland Tax Law program.
- Clarifies that, for the purposes of s. 77.585 (8) (a), Stats., a common carrier or the U.S. Postal Service must be considered the agent of the seller, regardless of any f.o.b. point and regardless of the method by which freight or postage is paid.
