

## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

## 2015 Wisconsin Act 337 [2015 Assembly Bill 872]

**Garnishment Fees** 

An earnings garnishment is an action to collect an unsatisfied civil judgment from earnings payable by the garnishee (e.g., the debtor's employer) to the debtor. Wisconsin law provides that a creditor must pay a \$15 fee to the garnishee for each earnings garnishment or each stipulated extension of that earnings garnishment and a \$3 fee to the garnishee for each payment delivered to the creditor after the first payment.

Act 337 clarifies that the \$3 fee paid by the creditor to the garnishee is applied to each payment after the initial payment.
