**2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 509**

Assembly Bill 509 requires the Department of Transportation to erect and maintain several directional signs for the Iola Old Car Show. Under the bill, no state funds, other than contributions from interested parties may be used for the fabrication, erection, or maintenance of the signs.

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1**

Assembly Amendment 1 removes the word “old” from the name of the Iola Car Show.

**BILL HISTORY**

Representative Petersen offered Assembly Amendment 1 on January 11, 2016. On February 11, 2016, the Assembly Committee on Transportation recommended adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 by a vote of Ayes, 11; Noes, 0, and passage of Assembly Bill 509, as amended, by a vote of Ayes, 14; Noes, 0.
