


## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO



## 2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 771

Assembly Bill 771 requires the Department of Justice (DOJ) to award grants for drug law enforcement and interdiction services to the Lafayette County Sheriff's Department in the amount of \$50,000 in fiscal year 2015-16 and in the amount of \$50,000 in fiscal year 2016-17.

## **ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2**

Assembly Amendment 2 decreases the amount of the grant for fiscal year 2015-16. Specifically, under the amendment, DOJ must award grants for drug law enforcement and interdiction services to the Lafayette County Sheriff's Department in the amount of **\$20,000 in fiscal year 2015-16** and in the amount of **\$50,000 in fiscal year 2016-17**.

## **BILL HISTORY**

On February 4, 2016, the Joint Committee on Finance offered Assembly Amendment 2. On that same date, the Joint Committee on Finance recommended: (1) adoption of the amendment on a vote of Ayes, 12; Noes, 3; and (2) passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 13; Noes, 2.
