2015 SENATE BILL 87

2015 Senate Bill 87 requires the Department of Safety and Professional Services to promulgate rules requiring an inspection of any addition to, or any remodeling, improvement, or other alteration of, a one-family or two-family dwelling if the cost of the project is more than 20% of the assessed value of the dwelling. Under the bill, this requirement does not apply to repair projects.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Amendment 1 clarifies that local governments may choose to require inspections of projects for which inspections are not required under the bill.

BILL HISTORY

On June 30, 2015, the Senate Committee on Insurance, Housing and Trade introduced and recommended adoption of Senate Amendment 1 and recommended passage of Senate Bill 87, as amended, by votes of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.
