## 2015 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 68

September 28, 2015 – Introduced by Representatives KNODL, BRANDTJEN and J. OTT, cosponsored by Senator DARLING. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1       **Relating to:** the life and public service of Dr. Ronald H. Lingren.

2               Whereas, former Representative Dr. Ronald H. Lingren was born on June 26,  
3       1935, and died on June 1, 2015; and

4               Whereas, Dr. Lingren was born in Gowrie, Iowa, the son of a tenant farmer and  
5       grade school teacher, graduated from Iowa State University in 1960, and earned his  
6       Ph.D. from the University of Iowa in 1961; and

7               Whereas, Dr. Lingren spent many years as a psychologist and professor at the  
8       University of Wisconsin–Milwaukee and received the title of Professor Emeritus  
9       while maintaining his own psychology practice; and

10              Whereas, Dr. Lingren served in the Army during the Korean War and with the  
11       Air Force Reserve for almost 40 years; and

12              Whereas, Ronald Lingren, a Democrat, served as a full-time legislator from  
13       1975 to 1981 for the 97th Assembly District in Menomonee Falls; and
