## 2015 SENATE BILL 730

February 11, 2016 - Introduced by Senators L. TAYLOR and HARRIS DODD, cosponsored by Representatives BERCEAU, HEBL, SUBECK, C. TAYLOR and ZEPNICK. Referred to Committee on Education.

1     **AN ACT** *to amend* 119.32 (5), 119.40 (title) and 119.40 (1) (a); and *to create* 118.21  
2     (5) of the statutes; **relating to:** wages to be paid to substitute teachers.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill requires a school board to pay to a substitute teacher who has taught in the same classroom for a period of 30 consecutive school days the same daily wage that would be paid to a regular classroom teacher in the same or an equivalent classroom.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

3     **SECTION 1.** 118.21 (5) of the statutes is created to read:  
4     118.21 (5) School boards shall give to a substitute teacher who teaches in the  
5     same classroom for a period of 30 consecutive school days a daily wage equivalent to  
6     the per diem salary established for a classroom teacher in the same or an equivalent  
7     classroom.
