**SENATE AMENDMENT 2,  
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 843**

March 20, 2018 - Offered by Senators ERPENBACH, RISSER, MILLER, SCHACHTNER, L. TAYLOR, RINGHAND, CARPENTER, WIRCH, LARSON, JOHNSON, HANSEN and SHILLING.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 7: delete "safety;" and substitute "safety; waiting period for  
3 purchase of handguns;"

4 **2.** Page 10, line 23: after that line insert:

5 "SECTION 23g. 175.35 (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 **175.35** (title) **Purchase Waiting period for the purchase of handguns.**

7 **SECTION 23h.** 175.35 (2) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

8 175.35 (2) (d) The ~~Forty-eight hours have elapsed from the time that the~~  
9 firearms dealer has received an approval a confirmation number regarding the  
10 firearms restrictions record search under sub. (2g) (c) from the department of justice  
11 and the firearms dealer has not been notified that the person is prohibited under

1 state or federal law from possessing a firearm or that the department needs an  
2 extension under sub. (2g) (c) 4. c.

3 **SECTION 23i.** 175.35 (2g) (c) 4. c. of the statutes is amended to read:

4 175.35 (2g) (c) 4. c. If the search indicates that it is unclear whether the person  
5 is prohibited under state or federal law from possessing a firearm and the  
6 department needs more time than provided under sub. (2) (d) to make the  
7 determination, the department shall make every reasonable effort to determine  
8 whether the person is prohibited under state or federal law from possessing a firearm  
9 and notify the firearms dealer of the results as soon as practicable but no later than  
10 5 working days after the search was requested.”.

11 **3.** Page 12, line 12: after that line insert:

12 **“SECTION 30g. Initial applicability.**

13 (1) The treatment of section 175.35 (title), (2) (d), and (2g) (c) 4. c. of the statutes  
14 first applies to sales that occur on the effective date of this subsection.”.
