## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires the Department of Public Instruction to award grants to teams of pupils in the 6th through 12th grades for the purpose of participating in science competitions. As a condition of receiving a grant, a team of pupils must demonstrate that it will provide funds to match the grant amount. DPI may not award a grant for this purpose in amount that exceeds \$5,000.

State:

Increase state expenditures by (up to) \$250,000 GPR in FY19. The Department would incur additional work related to grant administration; it is possible that the Department could absorb additional costs related to a new grant program of this size and scope from its existing budget.

Local:

Indeterminate. It is unknown how many eligible applicants will apply for and receive a grant under the new program. The grant could support 50 grants awards at the maximum grant amount of \$5,000; or more, if grant awards were less than \$5,000. The net impact to school districts (costs of programming and grant award revenues) are indeterminate.

## Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The \$250,000 GPR appropriated beginning in FY19 would be an ongoing state expenditure unless it was changed in the future by the Legislature.
