Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, an agency must prepare a statement of the scope of any administrative rule the agency plans to promulgate. Under the bill, a statement of scope expires 30 months after publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register. The bill first applies to statements of scope published in the Wisconsin Administrative Register the first Monday after publication.

This provision has no fiscal effect on the department.
