Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill has no fiscal effect on the department.

The department currently has sixteen rulemaking projects in progress, five of which are more than 2.5 years old since publication of their respective scope statements. The department can complete final draft rules for all sixteen of those rulemaking projects within the additional 2.5 years allowed by this bill.

To the extent the bill hastens this agency's rulemaking process by requiring completion of a final draft rule within 2.5 years, any associated costs or workload impacts can be absorbed using existing funds and staff.
