Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill makes various changes to the regulation of aquaculture and fish farms.

A. One-Time Costs

The bill is expected to result in an increased one-time workload related to updating program procedures and databases, legal review of documents, training staff, and conducting customer outreach.
