Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) must award a grant to a school district in the amount of \$1,000 per student, who in the prior school year, obtained a high school diploma and successfully completed an industry-recognized certification program as approved by DWD. SB 127 removes the per student limitation on these grants to school districts. Under the bill, DWD must award \$1,000 for each certification program completed by a student. The bill also changes the funding appropriation for the grant program from sum certain to sum sufficient.

The Wisconsin Technical Colleges System does not anticipate incurring any additional costs related to this legislation.
