Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Section 174.055, Stats., allows dogs trained to lead blind or deaf persons or to provide support for mobilityimpaired persons to be exempt from annual dog license fees. This bill provides further exemptions for any dog trained which provides specific physical or therapeutic functions from annual dog license fees.

The department receives approximately \$85,000 annually in revenue from this program. It is unknown how many dogs meet this new exemption criteria. Thus, the fiscal effect of this bill is indeterminate

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
