## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Currently, under s. 173.07 (5) (b), Stats., humane officers are prohibited from carrying a firearm unless he or she is also a law enforcement officer. This bill would eliminate that prohibition.

There is no requirement that a humane officer obtain a firearm to do his or her job. Thus it would be a voluntary cost to the humane officer to obtain a firearm. There should be no fiscal cost to the state, or the governmental unit that employs humane officers.
