## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin has authority to address complaints related to the conditions or compensation for the use of transmission equipment and property, including an attachment to a pole, by any public utility, video service provider, or telecommunications provider. The Public Service Commission also has authority to address complaints by a qualified complainant regarding the reasonableness of municipal regulations governing the use by a public utility, telecommunications provider or video service provider of the streets, highways or other public places within the municipality.

AB 348 would establish the process and maximum rates for co-location of small wireless facilities on governmental poles and utility poles for designated services, as well as the maximum rates and conditions associated with use of the right-of-way with respect to the construction or co-location of a wireless facility or wireless support structure in the right-of-way. The bill provides that a court of competent jurisdiction shall determine all complaints.

The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin may incur staff time associated with disputes concerning the possible jurisdictional conflicts between AB 348 and existing law.
