Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill would create four new appropriations for various grants to technical colleges, for a total increase in GPR appropriations of \$49 million over the 2017-19 biennium (\$23 million GPR 2017-18 and \$26 million GPR in 2018-19.

The new appropriations would include the following (a) workforce growth program (\$20,000,000 GPR annually); (b) dual enrollment opportunity grants (\$3,000,000 in 2018-19); (c) innovation grants (\$500,000 GPR annually); and (d) veterans success grants (\$2,500,000 GPR annually).

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Under the bill, dual enrollment opportunity grants would sunset on June 30, 2019. Veterans success grants would sunset on June 30, 2019. The workforce growth program and innovation grants would be ongoing appropriations.
