#### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill eliminates buyer identification (BID) cards and all associated requirements and restrictions specific to the purchase of motor vehicles from a salvage pool. In calendar year 2017, WisDOT issued 1,309 BID cards at a cost of \$6 per year. This proposal would result in an annual revenue loss of \$7,854.
