Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This fiscal estimate considers only those provisions of the bill that would apply to the Legislative Fiscal Bureau (LFB). The bill would require the LFB, along with the Departments of Public Instruction and Administration, to annually certify an estimate of the funding needed to meet the percentages of state support that would be established under the bill. The LFB could do this certification with existing resources.
