## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The bill authorizes the Department of Administration to contract with a private service provider for payments to provide social, employment or correctional services to individuals. The bill also creates a nonlapsible trust fund to be known as the "pay for success trust fund," from which payments under the contract are to be made. DOA may not execute a contract unless DOA determines that the contract is expected to result in significant performance improvements or significant budgetary savings for the state or a local governmental unit.

Nonstatutory provisions require the Departments of Health Services, Corrections, Children and Families, and Workforce Development to submit, after study, reports to the legislature concerning the programs these departments administer and advise whether and how the kind of contracting provided under the bill could be utilized as an alternative to current funding models for those agencies' provisions of program services.

The Department of Workforce Development estimates additional, indeterminate staff time and costs to prepare the report required under the bill.

## **Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

The long-range fiscal implications of the proposed bill are indeterminate at this time.
