Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill allows the Department to undertake rulemaking to determine the locations under its jurisdiction where the operation of these devices is prohibited.

Rulemaking will take approximately 200 hours at a cost of approximately \$4,800. This is a one-time cost.

The rulemaking is permissive. Counties and municipalities may also create ordinances specifying where the operation of these devices is prohibited. Costs for political subdivisions are indeterminate and permissive.
