## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, certain prescribers are allowed to prescribe epinephrine auto-injectors in the name of authorized entities, which are subject to certain storage and training requirements. SB 209 allows prescribers to prescribe these auto-injectors to authorized individuals who meet the same requirements, providing the same liability exemptions as exist for authorized entities.

The Department of Health Services is responsible for reviewing and authorizing training programs that are used to meet the requirements to become an authorized entity. Each review requires several hours of time from a Health Services Management Supervisor and Physician Management. Provided the expanded population authorized by this bill does not generate much more demand for new training/presentations across the state, it is possible that the additional costs associated with this staff time can be absorbed within the Agency's Budget.
