Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires HEAB to enter into an agreement with individuals who the Small Farm Higher Education Debt Council have found to satisfy the eligibility requirements. HEAB must find that the repayment period of each student does not exceed ten years; and that the individual has entered into a repayment plan with the federal Dept of Education. In the agreement the individual must express their commitment to pursue a long term career in farming in this state and make a good faith effort to comply with the requirements of this program. If the individual decides to leave the state or ceases the primary occupation of a small farm then they must notify HEAB within 60 days. If the agreement is terminated the individual is liable for a specified portion of the individuals most recent annual payment. HEAB is required to make five annual payments of equal amounts to individuals who satisfy the bills requirements.
