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Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill makes various changes to statutes relating to agency administrative rulemaking.

The requirement to prepare a retrospective economic analysis will result in an indeterminate amount of staff time for the Department's economist and the responsible bureau rule writer/coordinator to complete.

The expedited process for repealing rules will have no fiscal impact.

The requirement to prepare a biennial report to the Joint Committee for Review of Administrative Rules (JCRAR) will require an indeterminate amount of staff and/or LTE time for analysis and preparation of the report.

The requirements pertaining to agency review of legislative enactments will have no fiscal impact since they are already part of current agency practice.
