Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates the Employment First initiative, which requires all publicly funded programs that provide services and supports to working-age persons with disabilities (ages 16 and up) to prioritize competitive integrated employment when supporting the participation of these individuals in activities outside their homes. The bill requires the Department to:

- 1. Along with the Department of Workforce Development and the Department of Public Instruction, lead a collaboration focused on administering programs across all State agencies that promote competitive integrated employment for individuals with disabilities in Wisconsin;
- 2. Collaborate with the Department of Workforce Development and the Department of Public Instruction, with input from external stakeholders, to develop a plan (updated biennially) establishing specific performance improvement targets and methods to coordinate programs, policies, and procedures to support competitive integrated employment among all State agencies;
- 3. Develop and publish an annual report on the Department's progress, outcomes, achievements and barriers related to implementing the Employment First initiative;
- 4. When the Department publishes its first annual report, the Department must also submit a report to the Governor and the Wisconsin Legislature on the feasibility and estimated cost of conducting an independent study on the impact of the Employment First initiative on access to allowable services, quality of life, level of community integration, and overall satisfaction of persons with disabilities in Wisconsin.

It is estimated that the Department would need to hire one limited-term employee (LTE) to implement the work associated with the requirements of this bill. Assuming 1,040 work hours per year, ongoing annual costs for this position are estimated at \$34,000 all funds (\$17,000 GPR/\$17,000 FED) per year.
