Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

State Fiscal Effect: None. Signs installed would be on county or local roadways, not WisDOT roadways. Therefore, there would be no short or long-term cost impact to WisDOT. If a sign was needed on a state highway, WisDOT could permit the county or local unit of government to place a sign at their cost on the state highway.

Local Fiscal Effect: The fabrication and installation cost is calculated at \$150.00 per sign. The number of signs needed are indeterminate because WisDOT cannot project the need local units of government will have for the prescribed signage in the proposed legislation. Additionally, the amount of potential revenue from violation citations local units of government could raise from their ordinance enforcement cannot be projected.
