## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill removes rental-purchase agreements from the Wisconsin Consumer Act. There are no fees being introduced for the regulation of this industry.

Currently, there are 15 rent-to-own companies in the state. It is indeterminate at this time the number of complaints the Department of Financial Institutions would receive. However, at this time, with the current workload of the Division of Financial Licensing, one full time employee would be requested, for an annual cost of (\$47,500 Salary + \$17,000 Fringe) = \$64,500.
