Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill provides \$400,000 GPR in SFY 19 to the Department of Children and Families for grants to counties, tribes, and non-profits to support foster parents and provide normalcy for children in out-of-home care. Qualifying expenses may include:

- · retention incentives for foster parents,
- enhancing foster parent education, or
- reimbursing foster parents for foster care related expenses.

DCF is also required to report to the appropriate legislative standing committees by June 30, 2021 on the effectiveness of the program in reaching its stated goals.

DCF is able to absorb the costs of administering the grants and reporting on the program's effectiveness. Therefore, the fiscal effect is \$400,000 for the grants provided under the bill.
