Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill creates an exemption from licensure for complementary and alternative health care practitioners. The bill could lead to an increase in the number of complaints against individuals with the department's Division of Legal Services and Compliance, as there may be confusion as to who needs to be licensed. The department has no way to determine the number of potential complaints.
