## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Senate Bill 680 (SB 680) repeals a requirement that Milwaukee County transfer a parcel/property (929 North Water Street) within the City of Milwaukee to the Wisconsin Center District. Under SB 680, Milwaukee County would retain ownership of this parcel/property. Since Milwaukee County is the current owner of 929 North Water Street, no costs above the current costs of ownership would be imposed by SB 680.
