Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits a court from according deference to agency interpretations of law in cases involving review of an agency final decision and prohibits agencies from seeking deference in any proceeding to agency interpretations of law. The bill also specifies a process for adoption of a guidance document and provides that a settlement agreement, consent decree, or court order does not confer rule-making authority and cannot be used by an agency as authority to promulgate rules.

The provisions of the bill prohibiting a court from according deference to agency interpretations of law and that prohibit agencies from seeking deference in any proceeding interpretations of law may result in additional lawsuits against OCI resulting in increased costs. Additionally, it may also create uncertainty in the insurance industry in the effect of certain insurance regulations.
